This award is named after esteemed entrepreneur, Bill McNally; scholar, veteran, and community leader. Bill was a proud Penn State graduate and served as a Captain in the Marine Corps. Bill founded Noble Biomaterials where he was President and inventor of X-Static, a world-renown silver anti-bacterial technology. Under his leadership, Noble Biomaterials was recognized as one of the most successful privately held companies in the United States by Forbes, CNN, PBS, CNBC, Fortune, The New York Times, and the Wall Street Journal. More importantly, Bill had a special gift for making everyone feel important and special. He was known for treating everyone as “an old friend” which meant that whether you were a student or professional there was always time for listening, encouraging, and examining what was possible. Upon retiring from Noble Biomaterials in 2008, Bill was selected as a Ph.D. candidate at Marywood University as well as an adjunct professor at Lackawanna College.
